

HEALTHY SUBJECTS NEEDED FOR A BEHAVIORAL STUDY

The Ernest Gallo Clinic and Research Center at UCSF, in collaboration with UC Berkeley, is seeking a healthy group of comparison subjects for a **study of alcohol** use disorders.

To be eligible, you must:

- 1) Be between 18 - 50 years old
- 2) Be a light **social drinker** (for women: less than 7 drinks / week; for men, less than 8 drinks / week) **or a non-drinker**
- 3) Have **no significant medical or psychiatric illnesses** (such as anxiety or panic disorders, bipolar disease, major depression, or schizophrenia)
- 4) **Not currently be using any psychoactive medications**
- 5) Have no major health problems
- 6) Be able to read and speak English
- 7) Be able to undergo an **MRI scan**
- 8) Be willing to provide a blood sample for gene testing

This is a study that involves **three sessions**, on separate days, to take place on the **U.C. Berkeley** or U.C. San Francisco campuses, or on sites affiliated with those campuses.

On both the second and third sessions, you will be given a **one-time dose of either a medication or a placebo** (sugar pill).

As a participant, you will be paid \$12/hour for every hour of behavioral testing, \$20/hour for every hour of MRI testing, and a completion bonus of \$100.

We anticipate that subjects who complete the study
will earn approximately \$350.
